Severe bleeding: First aid - Mayo Clinic For severe bleeding, take these first-aid steps and reassure the injured person. Remove any clothing or debris on the wound. Don't remove large or deeply embedded objects. Don't probe the wound or attempt to clean it yet. Your first job is to stop the bleeding. Wear disposable protective gloves if available.
