A local anesthetic (e.g. lidocaine) is administered in the area where the surgery is to be performed. Local anesthetic is used in conjunction with the other methods of anesthesia in all oral surgery procedures. IS HEAT STERILIZATION OF LOCAL ANESTHETIC DRUGS A ... Heat sterilization of all local anesthetic drugs and equipment is mandatory but is not being generally practiced. A survey of the techniques observed in using local anesthetic drugs showed that only 33 out of 101 hospitals were autoclaving the solutions before use.
