Stevens Arms - Wikipedia Stevens Arms was an American firearms manufacturer founded by Joshua Stevens in 1864 in Chicopee Falls, MA. The company introduced the .22 Long Rifle round and made a number of rifle, shotgun, and target pistol designs. By 1902 they were advertising themselves as "the largest producers of sporting arms in the world". They were purchased by New England Westinghouse on May 28, 1915 and again by Bargain Basement Catalog - OldGuns.net 16885 BARGAIN U.S. M1892 Krag Bayonet & Scabbard - Used with all the Krag rifles 1892-1898 models. The bayonet is dated 1900 and is VG-fine condition except it has been sharpened during its period of use, and there is a small rectangle of wood chiseled out on the left grip, probably where a "9 NY" unit marking once was. Blowback (firearms) - Wikipedia Principle of operation. The blowback system is generally defined as an operating system in which energy to operate the firearm's various mechanisms and provide automation is derived from the movement of the spent cartridge case pushed out of the chamber by rapidly expanding powder gases. This rearward thrust, imparted against the breech, is a direct result of the expansion of propellant gases.
